The Foundation has started accepting entries through its website until 18 September 2022. The 9 categories of awards include the Distinguished Student (local), the Distinguished Student (GCC), the Distinguished University Student (local), the Distinguished Teacher (local and GCC), the Distinguished Educator (local), the Distinguished School (local and GCC), the Hamdan-ALECSO Award for Distinguished Educational Research, and the local for Education-Supporting Institutions award.

Dr. Jamal Al Mehairi, Vice Chairman of the Board of Trustees and General Secretary of Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance, said "After 25 years of its establishment, the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance continues its pioneering journey in supporting education and fostering talented and innovative experiences that advance the educational process, which is the backbone of progress and development of the Arab wardd"

of the Arab world". He added, "Over the years, the award has proven its distinction through delivering impressive results that leave a clear impact on the education sector of the UAE, Gulf and the Arab world, and through the 25th session, we are confident in the award's contribution to add more excellence and pioneering experiences in order to support education that plays a crucial role in leading the region towards further progress and prosperity". He urged everyone who meets the parameters to apply for the award that provides excellent opportunities for applicants to transform their innovative ideas into reality that will help in bettering education in various parts of the region".

New Standards

In accordance with the new standards of the 25th session of the awards of the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance, an evaluation system for all categories was developed through the design of an evaluation tool, 'the Rubric Marker', training sessions for participants and arbitrators that were designed and prepared specifically, as well as the application of a pilot phase of the new standards to a group of target people. The improvement of the

standards includes training and familiarizing participants with the new standards and their requirements, details, and conditions in order to be fully prepared to participate effectively and increase their chances of winning the various categories of the award. Training services for the 25th edition have also been developed through virtual training programs, induction films, further meetings, and visits to universities and schools to raise awareness about awards, question sessions, launch of inquiry response services through a hotline and e-mail, and answering the frequently asked questions through the website and automatic response.

According to the award stages, the Hamdan bin Rashid AI Maktoum Foundation will launch a series of educational campaigns to explain the current approved electronic submission to apply for the award categories at the local and Gulf levels where the winners of the awards will be announced by the end of December 2022.

The chairmen of the development committees for the awards standards of the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Per-formance stressed that the criteria developed for the various categories of the Foundation's awards provide a clear roadmap for improving educational performance. The new standards serve as a lever for those wishing to ascend and excel in the edu-cation system. They pointed out that all changes and developments are but a reflection of the emerging sciences and theories in the field of education, its quality, and improvement.

In addition, the chairmen affirmed that the new form of the criteria of some categories are similar to the international European accreditation, and focus on continuous development and improvement of performance, while honoring and appreciating those who have achieved high productivity. Thus, the developed criteria are expected to con-

tribute to achieving leadership in all fields, supporting the competitiveness of educators and enhancing their performance to make a qualitative leap in education.

Dr. Ali Al Kaabi,

chairman of the awards criteria development committees of the of Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation, spoke about the benefits that the participants would get according to the developed criteria, confirming, "There are several benefits, perhaps the most important of which is their entry into the journey of excellence; as this will help the participant to enhance one's strengths, build on, and develop them. Such journey will assist participants to discover the areas that require

improvement and development." Dr. Al Kaabi added. "The criteria of awards' different categories are a clear roadmap for those wishto reach ing excellence and their improve educational per-

formance."

Dr. Al Kaabi pointed out that the educational field is characterized by dynamism and rapid development, due to the development of science and the nature of the era which has new requirements every day. Therefore, the development of standards at the Foundation came to keep pace with such changes and developments, and to be a reflection of the last emerging science and theories in education, its quality, and improvement.

He explained that the new criterial will serve as a lever for those wishing to ascend and excel in the educational system, whether at the level of school, teacher, student, or educators working in the field, so all pillars of the educational process have received their share of development in the new criteria. Dr. Al-Kaabi stated that the best international practices in quality have been utilized and adapted in a manner commensurate with the educational field, by committees and experts qualified with the required knowledge and experience that can assist them to provide the best criteria in different categories.

As for the number of participations, Dr. Al Kaabi expected that it would witness a significant increase, due to several reasons, includ-ing the amendment of the standards that would allow the participation of every-one, even those who had previously won in previous sessions, as by virtue of the developed criteria the awards would be considered as new prizes not previously won by anyone. The increase is also due to the fact that there are more sub-categories that help attract a larger and diverse number of participants, such as the student category, where there will be an award for the student in general education, and another one for the university student, and these two categories have also been subdivided into an award for the outstanding student in the academic field and the other for the outstanding student in the nonacademic field.

Updates

Dr. Rashid Alrivami, chairman of the distinguished school category committee, stated that the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance developed the criteria for the Distinguished School award, by the help of experts in institutional excellence, after they were briefed on the most important updates in the field, as well as local and international excellence awards, based on a field application that included local government schools.

He pointed out that the criteria for the Distinguished School consist of 4 standards. First, planning and administrative organization, and this criterion aims at achieving pioneering strategic results through the periodic update and evaluation of its strategic school plan, and the effective application of its programs, projects and policies efficiently and effectively. The second criterion is the quality of the school community and partners, which focuses on achieving outcomes that delight all stakeholders and partners, and aims at en-

hancing their quality of life in a sustainable manner.

The third criterion, which is the leadership and nurturing of learners, provides an added value that meets the aspirations and needs of the learners. As for the fourth criterion, outcomes, it focuses on using appropriate and reliable performance indicators for all enablers, with the adoption of logical targets for its indicators.

Dr. Alriyami explained that what distinguishes these standards with their new look is the simulation of international European accreditation, such as using the diagnostic tool and scoring according to the logic of the RADAR, making it easier for the school to obtain international accreditations, espe-cially Hamdan-EFQM and other types of accreditations.

Harmony

Dr. Adeeb Jarrah, chairman of the distinguished educator category committee, said, "The Distinguished Educator is among the categories of the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance, which takes the initiative to work in harmony with national efforts to achieve the ten principles of the United Arab Emirates, and seeks to achieve continuous development in order

to keep pace with economic, political, technological, educational and developother ments. This category also adopts an agile and innovative approach to future challenges by exceptionally developing themes, and attracting distinguished people, consolidate to the principle of minds investment one hand, on and to create, on the other hand, a competitive and quality educational system, taking into account the recent develop-

ments and innovations." He continued, "The devel-oped category of Distinguished Educator constitutes a qualitative leap, as it focuses on the innovative and exceptional methodology that nurtures the field with the best practices to be utilized from, and stimulates innovation and proactiveness. It also focuses on several areas, including: the digital system, technology employment, innovation, and positive relationships, initiative, giving, and other pillars that keep pace with the interna-tional development."

The launch of the developed category of Distinguished Educator category, according to Dr. Jarrah, is a transition towards a new path with multiple purposes and goals at the local level, aiming at serving the needs and future

aspirations for leadership in the educational sector. He pointed out that the award in its new form is based upon several selected themes for the choosing and evaluating the educational competencies of the candidates, consisting of an innovative methodology by 25%, exceptional practices by 25%, unprecedented outcomes by 40%, and development and knowledge exchange by 10%

Dr. Jarrah stressed that to achieve the

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

For the First Time Ever Qualifying Batch of "Certified Arbitrator" at the GCC Level





The Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance announced the launch of the Certified Arbitrator program for the first time, as the Foundation qualified the first batch of it at the level of the GCC region.

This ambitious program aims at introducing and training on the new evaluation criteria and mechanisms, as well as the trainees' tests. The test takers are expected to obtain a certificate and a license of the arbitrator certified by the Foundation.

In the context of the program, the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance organized a series of training workshops for its awards' arbitrators in the Gulf region.

These training workshops aimed at training and qualifying coordinators and teams in the Gulf States for the initial evaluation of the participations in the various awards of the Foundation in their countries, sorting them and raising the eligible participations for central arbitration to be held in Emirate of Dubai.

The program comes within the framework of the Foundation's efforts to achieve its strategic goals, to support its partners, for the success of the 25th edition of its awards, to upgrade arbitration systems, and to enhance arbitration integrity for all participants in all awards categories.

Accurate Evaluation

Dr. Jamal Al Mehairi, Deputy Chairman of the Board of Trustees and Secretary-General of the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance, confirmed that this new program targets the Foundation's awards coordinators and teams of arbitrators in the Gulf Cooperation Council Countries.

Council Countries. He said, "The Hamdan bin Rashid Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance is keen on upgrading its awards by ensuring that all participants receive an accurate evaluation in their quest to win the award, and to provide the education system with their innovative experiences."

It is worth mentioning that the program's training kit has been designed and prepared by specialists and academics, as it includes the arbitrator's guide and activities, and a test form that contains a case study and preparation of a feedback report.

Achieving Leadership

Dr. Al Mehairi added, "This Program, which we launched for the first time, comes within the framework of the Foundation's keenness to achieve leadership in educational performance excellence and nurturing the gifted and innovators, fulfilling its goals to contribute to achieving the qualitative leap in education. The workshops we held are a means to improve and develop arbitrators' skills to implement arbitrations with high efficiency." Furthermore, these workshops provided a training for the arbitrators within a number of award categories, namely: the Distinguished Student, the Distinguished School, the Distinguished Teacher, the Distin-guished Educator, and the Distinguished University Student. In March 2022, the Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Distinguished Academic Performance launched a set of new criteria for the 25th edition of its annual awards, to keep pace with all changes in the education field, to qualify talents and ambitious projects aimed at promoting educational excellence, and to upgrade the entire educational system in the UAE and the region as well.

The Prize is to be awarded to the laureates during an official ceremony to be held in conjunction with World Teachers' Day on 5 October 2022 at UNESCO headquarters in Paris.

The international jury consists of 5 members who are chosen by the Director-General of UNESCO based on their high level of knowledge and great experience in issues related to teachers. They represent all geographical regions in the world according to the international classification.

Performance Quality

The UNESCO-Hamdan Prize for Teacher Development was founded in 2008 under the directives of Late Sheikh Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum, in cooperation with the United Nations Educational, Scientific and Cultural Organization (UNESCO). The Prize's objectives include supporting and enhancing the levels of education and improving the quality of learning worldwide, in order to achieve the objectives of Education for All. It facilitates the global sharing and dissemination of outstanding teacher practices.

Outstanding Practices

The Prize is awarded biennially for the three winners from around the world who provide outstanding educational practice contributing to improving the performance and effectiveness of teachers all over the world. The US\$ 300,000 reward is divided equally on the three winners.

The award requires that the projects eligible for application make a significant contribution to the promotion of teaching and learning, in line with UNESCO principles and objectives in this field. The project should be exemplary and stimulate similar initiatives, contain new intellectual resources. The project must be under implementation for a period of 3 years at least when applying for the Prize.

It should not be an academic requirement or a graduation project, and it is not incompatible with the regulations, policies, and ethics in force in the United Arab Emirates, taking into account the orientations of the UAE in terms of environmental preservation, rationalization, sustainability, energy, etc. Furthermore, the idea must have a great opportunity to be a product that could be adopted and welcomed by government institutions. Spring Program

In addition, the program aimed to enhance the participants' self-learning, creative thinking, and social communication skills.

Furthermore, special organized orientation sessions were provided in for students and their parents, as a part of the guidance and counseling programs for the purpose of educating them about their potentials and talents.

As a part of "basic" level, 15 talented students participated in "Design your Brand" workshop, during which they learned the meaning of a brand, and how it can be designed through visual elements, as well as the basics of designing websites that fit the product or the services provided, and how to reach the audience-attractive content using images and other elements.

using images and other elements. The "basic" level also included a workshop entitled "Adventure with LEGO Spike" targeted 15 talented students from the "basic" level.

During the workshop, the focus was placed on advanced principles of robotics, as the experience was rich with science, technology, engineering, and mathematics (STEM). In addition, the students programmed the robot in 10 different virtual environments using the Blocky programming language.

FabLab Spring Camp



To enroll in the Center, the student should be a citizen of the United Arab Emirates, studying

in grades (4 to 12). The student should have an outstanding genius or evident talent in one of the following disciplines (science - mathematics - technology - engineering - languages - leadership), and must pass the Foundation's accredited standards and the personal interview.
