### **Lofty Mission**




### **Educational Professionals** and Specialists Enrich the Forum



Dr. Al Muhairi added: "The program was created in collaboration with ICESCO's regional academic institutions, training centers, and scientific chairs with expertise in

non-native speaker Arabic language studies at numerous universities throughout the world. The program fits into the framework of the Hamdan Foundation and ICESCO's shared goal of improving the educational aspects of the Arabic language."

### **Quality and Sustainability**

Addressing the gathering, Mr. Adel Bouraoui, Advisor to ICESCO Director-General for External Centers and Academic Chairs on the Arabic Language, stressed that the Mishkat Program is part of the Organization's vision which emphasizes the need to ensure quality, sustainability, innovation, and alignment with the needs of Member States.
