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74 Winners of the Hamdan Foundation Awards in the 25th Cycle



Some 74 participants won in the 25th cycle of the Hamdan Foundation awards. 2 winners of the Applied Research Global Award of Gifted Education, 2 winners of the School Global Award Initiative of Gifted Education, 3 winners of the Hamdan-ICESCO Prize for Voluntary Development of Education Facilities in the Islamic World, and 4 research papers won the Hamdan-ALECSO Award for Distinguished Educational Research out of a total of 72 participating research papers from 13 Arab countries. Additionally, the number of winners in the Gulf competitions amounted to 14 in various categories. Saudi Arabia won 9 awards, Kuwait won 3, and Qatar and Bahrain each won 1 award.

At the local level, the number of distinguished winners reached 49 out of a total of 177 candidates who were shortlisted to final arbitration in the awards for Distinguished Student, Distinguished University Student, Distinguished Teacher, Distinguished Educator, and Distinguished School. The number of participants in the awards was 134 students from both general and higher education, including 84 students in the academic field and 49 students in the nonacademic field.



Hamdan Foundation Participates in an Educational Meeting on Creative Leadership to Improve School Performance




