Sheikh Rashid bin Hamdan Al Maktoum, Supreme Chairman of Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Medical and Educational Sciences, honored the winners of the Foundation's 2024 medical awards during a prestigious Hamdan Award for Distinguished ceremony hosted at Mohammed bin Personalities in healthcare.

Rashid University of Medicine and Health Sciences in Dubai.

The ceremony recognized winners across various categories, including the Arab Award for Research in Healthcare, the Arab Award in Genetics, the Best Research in Healthcare Award, the Innovation in Healthcare Award,

This year's winners included a distinguished group of researchers and specialists who have made significant scientific contributions in their fields. Among them was Professor André Megarbane, who won the Arab Award in Genetics in recognition of his pioneering work in human genetics. His achievements have enhanced scientific knowledge and advanced

the early diagnosis of genetic diseases in the Arab world.

In the category of the Arab Award for Research in Healthcare, two outstanding studies were honored. The first was conducted by a research team from King Faisal Specialist Hospital, focusing on challenges related to interpreting genetic variants in patients with Mendelian disorders. The second study, presented by a collaborative team from Hamad Medical Corporation in Qatar, Kuwait University, and Medipol University Istanbul, explored the transition to oral antibiotics for gram-negative bacteremia cases.

At the UAE level, a research team from Cleveland Clinic Abu Dhabi was honored with the Best Research in Healthcare Award for their study on improving care for testicular torsion cases through a multidisciplinary approach. Another team from the University of Sharjah, Al Qasimi Hospital, and Tawam Hospital won the Best Research in Healthcare Award for their innovative use of Al in treating pneumonia.

Hamdan Award for Distinguished Personalities in Healthcare was awarded to Dr. Ali Abdulkarim Al Obaidli, Consultant in Nephrology and Organ Transplantation, and Dr. Fathiya Fardallah Al Awadi, Consultant in Endocrinology and Diabetes, in recognition of their outstanding contributions to the development of the UAE's healthcare sector.

In the category of the Innovation in Healthcare Award, two initiatives were honored: the "UAE Lung Transplant Program – Hope with Every Breath," which has provided advanced solutions for patients in need of lung transplants, and the "Diabetes Risk Calculator for Ramadan Fasting," which developed innovative digital tools to improve diabetes management during Ramadan.

This event marked a significant milestone as the first edition following the launch of the Foundation's new identity last year, reflecting its unwavering commitment to supporting excellence and innovation in the medical and educational fields both locally and internationally.

Hamdan bin Rashid Al Maktoum Foundation for Medical and Educational Sciences and the Islamic World Educational, Scientific, and Cultural Organization (ICESCO) have announced the winners of the fourth edition of the Hamdan–ICESCO Prize for Voluntary Development of Educational Facilities in the Islamic World. This prize honors pioneering voluntary initiatives that support and enhance educational environments in Islamic countries.

Three distinguished institutions were selected for their outstanding projects in developing educational facilities, each receiving equal recognition. Hadramawt Foundation for Human Development from Yemen was awarded for its "Model Schools" project, which aims to establish and develop modern high schools in Hadramawt Governorate.

Heydar Aliyev Foundation from Azerbaijan received the prize for its "Educational and Social Support Program," focusing on constructing and rehabilitating schools in various countries within and beyond the Islamic world.

Additionally, Moroccan Foundation for Preschool Education from Morocco was honored for its initiative to equip primary education departments in rural, semi-rural, and urban areas throughout the kingdom.

The winners will be honored at an official ceremony to be organized soon, where each will receive a trophy and a financial reward to support the continuation of their educational projects.

The Hamdan-ICESCO Prize aims achieve multiple to strategic objectives, including encouraging and recognizing voluntary initiatives in education, promoting efforts to create new and sustainable educational environments, and supporting educational infrastructure in the Islamic world.
